

NPGA Board of Directors Section Descriptions

Distributors Section

- Member companies classified as “distributors” are represented by four directors on the NPGA Board.
- Distributor members are those companies and firms engaged in the wholesale marketing of appliances designed for the utilization of propane, propane containers, and other propane products.
- Each director serves a three-year term, with one (and in some cases two) director seats up for consideration each year.
- Meets twice a year in-person in conjunction with NPGA Board of Directors meetings.

Individual / Employee Section

- The Individual/Employee Membership Section is made up of employees of member companies who are interested in professional development and grassroots advocacy opportunities within the association. This membership is cost-free to employees.

International Section

- Member companies classified as “international” are represented by one director on the NPGA Board who serves a one-year term.
- International members are those headquartered outside the United States and Canada as well as members within the United States and Canada engaged in international affairs.
- Section meets as needed via teleconference as regular, in-person meetings do not occur in conjunction with NPGA Board meetings

Manufacturers Section

- Member companies classified as “manufacturers” are represented by fifteen members on the NPGA Board.
- Manufacturer members are persons, firms, corporations, or associations engaged in the manufacturing, assembly, and marketing of products used in the propane industry.
- Each director serves a three-year term, with five director seats up for consideration each year.
- Meets twice a year in-person in conjunction with NPGA Board of Directors meetings.

Propane Suppliers Section

- Member companies classified as “propane suppliers” are represented by nine directors on the NPGA Board.
- Each director serves a three-year term, with three director seats up for consideration each year.
- Propane supplier members are any individual, partnership, association, firm or corporation owning one or more petroleum refinery, natural gas, cycle or other gas processing plant wherein liquid hydrocarbons are recovered or extracted from natural gas.
- Meets twice a year in-person in conjunction with NPGA Board of Directors meetings.

Services Section

- Member companies classified as “services” are represented by four members on the NPGA Board, each serving a one-year term.
- Services members are persons, firms, or corporations providing services to the industry and supporting the purposes of NPGA.
- Meets twice a year in-person in conjunction with NPGA Board of Directors meetings.

Transportation & Storage Section

- Member companies classified as “transportation and storage” are represented by one director on the NPGA Board, who serves a one-year term.
- Transportation and storage members are people, firms, corporations, or associations doing business as a for-hire carrier with published tariffs on file with state or federal regulatory agencies.
- Section meets as needed via teleconference and regular in-person meetings do not occur in conjunction with NPGA Board meetings.
