NPGA's Technology, Standards and Safety (TS&S) Committee Chairs (past and present) select the award recipient(s).

NPGA SAFETY AWARD

1. Award Scope: The NPGA Safety Award is conferred upon a person, small company or branch of a large corporation in recognition of distinguished service to the cause of safety in the propane industry.

2. Nomination Procedures

- a. Nominees for the NPGA Safety Award may be proposed only by a member of the National Propane Gas Association. Nominations shall be sent in writing to the Chair of the Technology, Standards and Safety (TS&S) Committee by a detailed statement outlining the nominee's outstanding contribution to the safety of our industry.
- b. Not more than three awards shall be given in any one-year, and it shall not be required to give an award every year.
- c. The TS&S Committee Chairs (past and present) shall vote on all nominations received. It shall require two-thirds majority vote of the Committee Chairs voting to select an eligible candidate for this award. If this majority is not reached by the third ballot, balloting shall cease, and no recipient shall be elected for that year. The action of the Committee Chairs shall be final.

3. Award Notification: Not later than one month before the association annual meeting convenes, the TS&S Committee Chair shall notify the NPGA Chair and NPGA President as to whether or not a recipient has been elected. When a recipient is chosen, the name shall be kept confidential within the Committee, except the Chair shall issue the following notifications:

- a. The recipient of the award shall be notified no more than two months and not less than one month in advance of the presentation, and the recipient at the same time shall be advised that the notification is confidential and that the recipient shall in no way divulge or publicize this notification.
- b. The President of NPGA shall be given the recipient's name at the time the recipient is notified so that the award may be prepared for presentation. He and his staff shall be committed to complete secrecy.

4. Award Presentation: The award shall be presented by the TS&S Chair at NPGA's Annual Meeting.
